

Drop Hooks



Drop hooks are 180mm long and wound with twine. They are used in the production of greenhouse vegetable crops when training the plant up to the wire. The standard drop hook is wound with white twine (1/1200 = 1200lm per 1kg) 10m + 4m free fall or 11m + 3m free fall with aid of free fall clip.

Other options are available on request.

Twine colour: Orange and green twine is available and can be wound on the drop hooks. Different colours are use for taking extra stems when increasing stem density for the likes of tomato crops.

Twine Length: Any length of twine up to a max. 25m can be wound on the 180mm drop hook. Please note the twine is only guaranteed for 1year.

Free Fall: This clip system speeds up the hanging of hooks onto wires and drop the 'free fall' twine simply by removing the clip off the hook, dropping the twine down, ready to be fastened to the base of the plant stem. Originally this was a manual process to unwind the required amount of twine to reach the bottom of the plant stem.

Re-wind: We offer to rewind your old hooks if you supply them to us cleaned and stacked tidy in cartons.
