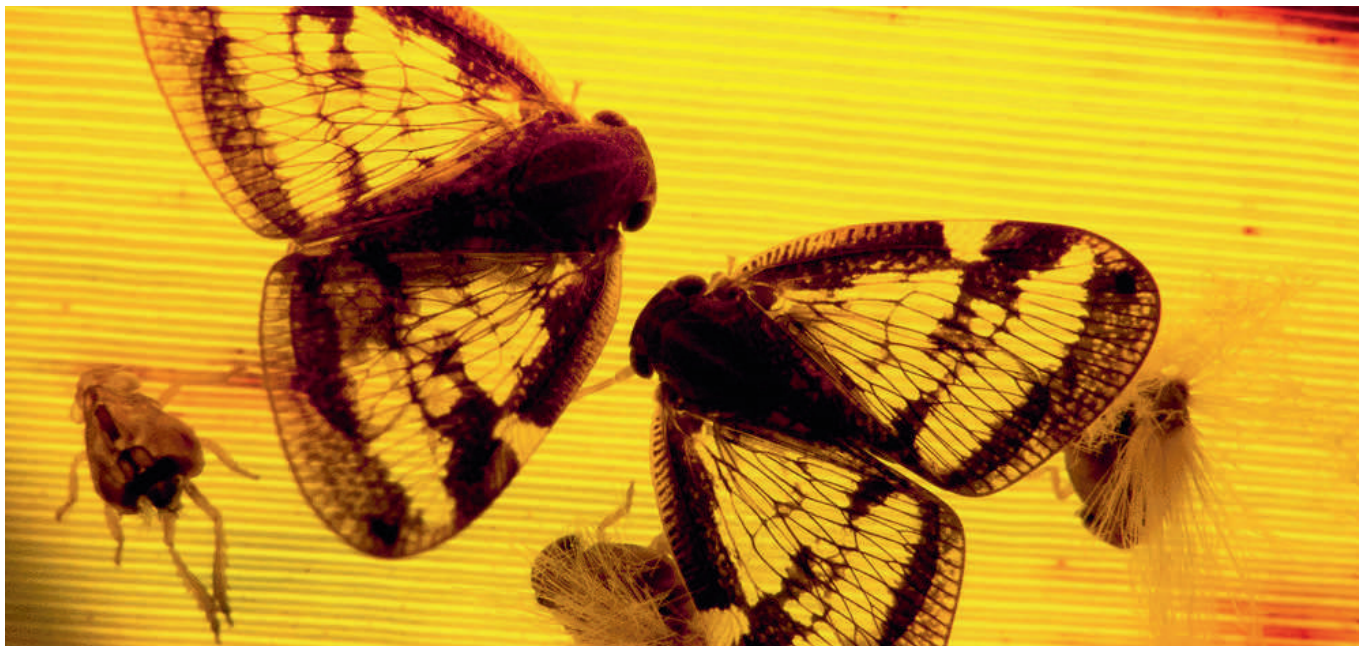

While Passion Vine Hopper (PVH) don't do much damage on their own, they excrete honeydew on which sooty mould develops. This can severely mark the fruit, with large stains often washing down from the top of the fruit, and cause rejections at packing.

First observed in January, PVH are most abundant in kiwifruit orchards in February-March. Close monitoring and adequate spraying are key to the management of this pest.
